We now have four cows and two hundred chickens! We are making lots of milk and now are starting to get eggs! We were able to build a weekend place where the children can go to help with the animals and farm.

These five young people just graduated from high school. Four of them have applied to university and have recently been accepted. We praise the Lord for the way He has provided and is making a way for them in life. The tallest one in the picture is staying on at the farm to help oversee it. Isn't God amazing? When we think of where these children have come from (abuse, neglect, abandonment, starvation) we are so grateful to the Lord that they can have a better life. Most importantly is has been a chance for them to know Him personally. God is good!



Our functioning bakery is bringing in some revenue that helps with special projects that they want to accomplish. The children are learning how to make breads and pastries as well as how to decorate cakes, which are in high demand. The many life skills that they learn will help them in future endeavors. What a blessing to be on the sidelines and see God work miracles for each one! The real blessing is each one of these children and the contribution they are to their world and to their Lord.



We praise God for the opportunity to build another building on the property! The boys will live in the new building and the girls in the old building. This potentially also allows more space for more children as staffing allows. God is continuing His work in perfect ways.
