She is also serving on the outreach team with the Awana program, has received awards for Biblical studies and is a big blessing in the home with the younger children. Now she wants to study odontology and go back to Hands of Love so she can take care of the children's dental needs. She has been offered a spot in a university at a cost more affordable. School starts in February in Bolivia so it's just around the corner!

We are trusting God to provide for Eloina. Will you pray with us that God would meet this need in Eloina's life and give her direction?

There are a lot of preparations involved to make the beginning of a school year happen for thirty-four children!
